## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PRESIDENT & BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BEECHER HELD AT THE BEECHER VILLAGE HALL, 625 DIXIE HIGHWAY, BEECHER, ILLINOIS APRIL 13, 2015 -- 7:00 P.M.

All present joined in the Pledge to the Flag.

President Szymanski called the meeting to order.

## ROLL CALL

PRESENT: President Szymanski and Trustees Cleary, Ahrendt, Meyer, Kypuros, Kuhlman and Wehling.

**RECOGNITION OF GUESTS:** Tom Brislane, a resident of Highlington Court, said he has lived here for 20 years and never had any problems of a criminal nature in his neighborhood and in the last week there was a break in on one of their homes and vandalism of one of their vehicles. Mr. Brislane asked if this had anything to do with the golf course closing. Chief Weissgerber was asked what is going on, why this is occurring and if the vandalism could be of a personal nature. Trustee Wehling made a motion to approve payment of a bill from the Firemen's #1 Lights Account, in the amount of \$6,600 to Affordable Lighting Source for 24 1500W fixtures. Trustee Kypuros seconded the motion.

Chief Weissgerber stated that the Police Department is set on plans for this event.

Trustee Cleary made a motion cancelling the May 25<sup>th</sup> Village Board meeting due to the Memorial Day Holiday, and holding a full Village Board meeting on Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>. Trustee Wehling seconded the motion.
