Beecher Non-Highway Vehicle Quick reference sheet

- All non-highway vehicles subject to registration except ATV's and off-highway motorcycles. Non-highway vehicles 64" width and 2000 pounds or less.
- Can only travel on Village of Beecher roads where the speed limit is 30 mph or less. CANNOT DRIVE ON DIXIE HIGHWAY OR INDIANA AVENUE or any other county road.
- Can cross Dixie Highway at a stop intersection where the speed limit on Dixie is 40 mph, Chestnut Street and Church Road.
- Can cross Indiana Avenue at intersections.
- Equipment required: Brakes, a steering apparatus, tires a rearview mirror, red reflectors in the front and rear, a slow moving emblem on the rear, a headlight, a tail light, brake lights and turn signals.
- Lights must be illuminated when driven on the roadway.
- Must have insurance on the non-highway vehicle.
- Must have a valid driver's license to operate the vehicle.
- May operate on sidewalks but cannot use crosswalks to cross Dixie Highway or Indiana Avenue. Care must be taken when operating on sidewalks; pedestrians have the right of way.
- Can only transport the allowable number of persons for the non-highway vehicle.
- Must have seat belts for anyone less than 18 years of age.
- Annual registration begins June 1st of each year at the cost of \$25.00.
