On 12-28-21, at 12:46AM, officers were called the 1400 block of Somerset Drive for a suspicious vehicle. Officers located the suspicious vehicle and attempted to stop it but it fled at a high rate of speed in a reckless manner and officers discontinued and notified surrounding towns. Later in the day it was determined through video that the occupants of the Mustang were car burglars pulling on car door handles. No reports of burglary were made to the police department.

On 1-2-22, an officer was called to take a report of theft from a business in the 900 block of Dixie Highway. A person called the business and asked an employee to honor a money pack card previously purchased for \$500. The employee complied by providing another card number without knowing that this is a common scam. No offender has been identified.

On 1-1-22, Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of N. Woodbury Road for a report of a domestic disturbance. One of the parties had left prior to police arrival and peace was restored. Officers determined that no physical violence had taken place. The party present was advised to call back police if the other party returned to the home.
